French
Revolution

proper noun

a rebellion of the French people against the king in 1789

neutral

noun

unbiased, not favoring either side in a conflict

Neutrality
Proclamation

proper noun

announcement by George Washington that the United States would not take sides with any European countries that were at war with each other

privateers

private ships hired by a country to attack its enemies

noun

Jay's Treaty

treaty that settled problems between the United States and Great Britain in the early 1790s

proper noun

Pinckney's Treaty

treaty that settled the border and trade problems with Spain

proper noun

Little Turtle

Miami chief who led an American Indian group to victory over U.S. forces in 1790

proper noun

Battle of Fallen Timbers

1794 battle between American Indians and U.S. forces, named for an area where many trees had been destroyed by a tornado

proper noun

Treaty of Greenville

treaty that gave the United States claim to most American Indian lands in the Northwest Territory

proper noun

Whiskey Rebellion

1794 rebellion by farmers against a tax on whiskey
